Dear School Administrator or Group Advisor,

The event is called: *"Put fun in Fundraising"*. This is the thirteenth year of this event and it is a great chance for students, their friends and family to get on the Mount Snow Tubing hill and enjoy the day, while raising money for their local school, and gain "community service hours".

The event, organized by the Deerfield Valley Rotary, will take place on Sunday, March 17th, 2010 at Mount Snow from 1pm – 3pm. Students may arrive anytime between 1:00pm and 2:30pm.

In addition to tubing, there will be a free barbeque for the participants that have raised money. Tubing and barbecue will be available to the public, with all proceeds going towards the Rotary Scholarship Fund.

Pledge Collection:

We encourage your students to collect pledges from friends and family members. 100% of the pledges collected will be returned to your designated school group. Additional funds raised at the event will be used for the Rotary Scholarship fund to award scholarships in local schools as well as continuing education for adults in the valley. ***The only thing you need to do is copy the pledge sheets, give them to your students and encourage them to participate!***

All money *must* be turned in on the day of the event with the pledge sheet. A release form for Mount Snow is included and must be signed by a parent or guardian in order for students to participate in the tubing. We encourage checks, if possible so that students are not handling a lot of cash. Checks can be made out to: Rotary Club of Deerfield Valley (RCDV).

All participants who turn in contributions will be eligible for tubing and a barbeque that day.

Rotary Tube-a-Thon

EXPRESS ASSUMPTION OF RISKS, INDEMNITY, FORUM SELECTION

AGREEMENT AND RELEASE

(PLEASE READ CAREFULLY & COMPLETE ALL SHADED AREAS)

WARNING! The sport of snow tubing presents many unique challenges heightened by the unevenness and unpredictability of ever-changing snow surfaces. This snow tubing activity can be a dangerous with numerous inherent and other risks including the steep, slippery, uneven conditions of the snow surface which may contain slush, bumps or icy conditions along with mats at the deceleration area.

I understand and acknowledge that snow tubing is a dangerous activity with inherent and other risks associated with the activity that can cause serious and even fatal injuries.

I understand that part of the thrill, excitement and risk of snow tubing is that the snow tubes all end up in a common, run out area at various times and speeds and that it is my responsibility to try and avoid hitting another snow tuber and it is also my responsibility to try to avoid being hit by another snow tuber, but that notwithstanding their efforts by myself and other snow tubers, there is a risk of collision.

I acknowledge and understand that some, but not necessarily all, of the risks of snow tubing including the following:

- fences and/or barriers at or along portions of the snow tubing area, the absence of such fences and/or barriers and the inability of fences and/or barriers to prevent or reduce injury;
• the chance that a snow tube can go from one run into another run, regardless of whether or not there is a barrier between runs, and the chance that the snow tube can go up and over the run out area;
• collisions in the run out area and other locations of the snow tubing facility, with such collisions happening between snow tubes, between snow tube and another person, between a snow tube and a snow tubing attendant, between snow tubing patrons who may or may not be in or trailing a snow tube at the time of the collision, and other sorts of collisions, collisions with fixed objects, obstacles or structure located within or outside the snow tubing facility.

I hereby agree to accept all of the risks of the sport of snow tubing, such as those listed above as I RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS Mount Snow, Ltd., its owners, agents and employees and any other land owners (hereinafter "Mount Snow") for any and all liability for personal injury, including death and property damage resulting from any such inherent and other risks, as I have agreed they are defined herein. I also agree that in the event that anyone makes any claim against Mount Snow as a result of any of my activities on their premises or the use of its facilities that I will INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS Mount Snow from such claims.

I further agree that this contract is binding upon me, my heirs and assigns. To the extent that I am signing this document on behalf of any minor, I represent and guarantee that I have full authority to do so realizing the full binding effect of this contract and I further agree to INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS Mount Snow for any claims brought on behalf of the minor relating to any injury or damages sustained by the minor while he/she was competing in this event at Mount Snow. This contract may also be plead as an affirmative defense to any claim that I may bring as a result of participating in the Tube-a-thon.

I further agree that any claim that I may at any time bring for any reason against the Mount Snow shall be submitted to the jurisdiction of the State or Federal Court in the State of Vermont and in no other jurisdiction and shall be adjudicated under Vermont Law.

If any portion of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, then all other parts shall remain in full force and effect.
